Accept Akhara's shebait rights, but not its tall claims, says Waqf board

THE SUNNI Wakf Board on Thursday told the Supreme Court that while they conceded the Nirmohi Akhara's claim for 'shebait' rights in Ayodhya, it was not willing to accept its "tall claims" about it being there from centuries ago.

A shebait, under Hindu law, is entrusted with the task of maintaining and preserving an idol and its property.

Appearing for the Wakf Board and M Siddiq, who are appellants in the matter. Senior Advocate Rajeev Dhavan told a five-judge Constitution Bench headed by Chief Justice of India Ranjan Gogoi that a distinction has to be made between the "credible and not credible" parts of the statements by the Akhara's witnesses. The Nirmohi Akhara is one of the three parties to the title suit.

The bench, also comprising Justices S A Bobde, D Y Chandrachud, Ashok Bhushan and S A Nazeer, is hearing appeals against the September 30, 2010 verdict of Allahabad High Court ordering a three-way division of the disputed 2.77 acres.

On Thursday, Dhavan tried to bring out alleged contradictions in the statements of the Akhara's witnesses. Intervening, Justice Chandrachud referred to Dhavan's statement that he was not opposed to shebait rights claimed by the Akhara and asked, "On the one hand, you admit their shebait rights. On the other, you say their evidence is

In the 74-second recording, Dubey alleges that a contractor is paying Singhar and Rajyavardhan Singh Dattigaon (Congress MLA from Badnawar) but is not ready to pay more money to Hiralal Alawa (Congress MLA from Manawar).

After the clip went viral on Wednesday, Chief Minister Kamal Nath summoned the minister and the two MLAs, and later ordered Dubey's removal from the district.

MATERNITY SCHEME IN JHARKHAND

155 of 202 applicants did not receive benefits, says survey

RANCHI, SEPTEMBER 5

AS MANY as 155 women out of a sample size of 202 who applied for Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY) did not receive their maternity entitlement, according to a survey conducted in six blocks of Jharkhand in June 2019.

Launched in 2017, PMMVY provides for maternity benefits of Rs 5,000 in three installments, but only for the first child.

The survey on the applicants was conducted by economist Jean Dreze and his teammates Shakina Dhorajiwala and Pallavi Pratibha in Basia and Raidih in Gumla, Manika in Latehar, Peterwar in Bokaro, Shikaripada in Dumka, and Sonua on West Singhbhum. In each block, the team claimed to have visited a "sample of anganwadis", with a total of 116 anganwadi centres in 42 gram panchayats, and interviewed pregnant and nursing women from the anganwadi workers' list.

Amitabh Kaushal, Principal Secretary, Department of Social Welfare, Women and Child Development said that more than 70 per cent of the targeted women had benefited, and questioned the sample size.

"Out of the target of 3.9 lakh, 2.9 lakh beneficiaries have been registered under the scheme, 2.41 lakh women got their first installment, 2.2 lakh women got their second installment and 1.2 lakh got their third installment, A total of Rs 92.5 crore has been

disbursed," he added. Speaking about the chal-

lenges faced by the women to avail of the benefits, Dreze said they have to fulfil conditions such as early registration of pregnancy, ante-natal check and immunisation of the child. "They also have to fill a long application form at the local anganwadi for each installment," he said.



Modi extends \$1 bn for Russia's Far East

ACT FAR EAST Says India will cooperate in the region's development

HT Correspondent

NEW DELHI: India on Thursday announced a \$1 billion line of credit for Russia's Far East, with Prime Minister Narendra Modi saving New Delhi will march beside Moscow to implement President Vladimir Putin's vision for developing the resource-rich region.

Modi made the announcement while speaking as chief guest at the Eastern Economic Forum in the Far Eastern port city of Vladivostok, a day after he held an annual summit with the Russian president and the two sides signed a raft of deals in areas ranging from energy to defence.

'Friends, to participate in the development of the Far East. India will give a line of credit of \$1 billion. This is the first time India is giving a line of credit to a specific region in a country," he said.

Noting that India's Act East policy had helped the country engage East Asia. Modi said: "Today's announcement will be the take-off point for Act Far East and I firmly believe this step will add a new chapter in our economic diplomacy.

India wants to march shoulder-to-shoulder in Russia's "visionary journey" to develop the Far East, which offers "historic opportunities" for his government's plans to make the

country a \$5-trillion economy by 2024, he told the gathering that included Putin, Japan Prime Minister Shinzo Abe, Malaysian Prime Minister Mahathir Mohamed and Mongolian President Khaltmaagin Battulga.

As part of preparations for his visit. Modi said, several union ministers, chief ministers of four states and 150 Indian businessmen travelled to the Far East and met their counterparts to boost trade. This resulted in the signing of some 50 business agreements worth \$5 billion, and Indian firms are interested in areas such as energy, healthcare, skill development and mining, he said.

Vladivostok could serve as a springboard to markets in Northeast Asia and the Far East could unite the Eurasian Union and an "open, free and inclusive Indo-

Pacific". Modi said. India is working for a rules-based order that respects sovereignty and territorial integrity and without any interference in the internal matters of countries, he added. Answering a question follow-

ing about sanctions imposed on oil trade. Modi said there was a debate on how such measures affect the global economy.

"I understand there is a big debate on this across the world that how much the country on which sanctions are imposed is affected. That is one thing, but because of the impact on other countries and, the world economy, there is deep concern and a debate on that across the world. he said. Modi. who arrived in Russia on Wednesday for a two-day visit, is the first Indian PM to visit the Far East region.

SC takes note of 'tall claims' by Nirmohi Akhara witnesses

NEW DELHI: The Supreme Court on Thursday took note of allegations of Muslim parties that many witnesses of Nirmohi Akhara made "tall claims" in their testimonies and asked them whether they still accept that it has rights over the disputed Ram Janmbhoomi-Babri masjid land at Ayodhya.

A five-judge Constitution bench headed by Chief Justice Ranjan Gogoi considered the submission of senior advocate Rajeev Dhavan, appearing for Sunni Waqf Board and others including original litigant M Siddiq, that there were "discrepancies" and "contradictions' in statements of witnesses examined by the Akhara.

"Somebody said Nirmohi Akhara came into being 700 years ago, some said 250 years ago... A witness said Lord Ram was there 12 lakh years ago... But. I cannot get away from the fact that there are records that Nirmohi Akhara was there in 1855-56 and a suit was filed (by Mahant Raghubar Das) in 1885," the senior advocate told the bench. A witness, who had testified in over 200 cases. believed that there was "no harm in telling a lie" if a place has been forcibly taken away, he said.

"Despite these contradictions." you still maintain that they (Nirmohi Akhara) have established their shebaiti (managing) rights," the bench asked.

"Laccept that Nirmohis are 'shebaits' of 'Ram Chabutara in outer courtvard. Some part (of statements of testimonies) is not credible. The tall claims are not correct," he said.

Transwoman may get Navy job back

NEW DELHI: Almost two years after she was dismissed from the Indian Navy for undergoing a sex reassignment surgery, Sabi Giri is one step from getting reinstated in the force.

The 27-year-old transwoman. who was a sailor, said the Navy has agreed to take her back on a lower division clerk level starting November-if she clears an exam. An official at the Navy confirmed the development.

"I am so happy to have my job back. I won't be a sailor anymore but at least I will have my pay and all my benefits," said Giri from Patna. Since her controversial dismissal in October 2017, Sabi has been living with the trans community and getting by with traditional methods of entertaining at weddings.

A Navy official said on condition of anonymity that the LDClevel position was the only alternative available in the case. "She couldn't have gone back to the ship. So the tradesman job is the best thing to do. I am confident she will clear the exam and then she can come back," the official

Sabi earlier served with the marine engineering wing at the Eastern Naval Command in Visakhapatnam. She moved to the administrative wing after her surgery that she underwent in at a hospital in Mumbai while on a 22-day leave in 2016. When she was dismissed in 2017, the Navy cited existing service rules and regulations for the decision.

'The existing service rules do not permit the sailor's continued employment owing to his altered gender status, medical condition and resultant employability restrictions," read a statement issued by the Navy at the time of her dismissal. Giri had altered her gender status from the one she was recruited for at the time of induction, the Navy had added

Giri challenged the decision in the Delhi high court, "They first offered her a contractual job. She completely rejected it." said her lawver Amritananda Chakravorty, "That's not just because of

the permanent status but also because she was getting half her salary," she added. The judges summoned Giri on

August 14, 2019, "The judges took me to their chamber and I told them everything," said Giri. The judges nudged the lawyers from both sides and officials of the Navy to come up with a solution.

Giri now plans to return to Delhi later this month and prepare for the exam. "We want her to come quick so that she can prepare." said Chakravorty.

Her lawyers pointed out that the job offer doesn't have any impact on the ongoing legal challenge to her dismissal, "This offer was without prejudice to her contention that her termination was unlawful," said Tripti Tandon of Lawver's Collective Chakravorty said the Navy

shouldn't just go by her formal qualifications - a high school graduate. "She has served the Navy for seven years, which has to be counted while deciding the post she is eligible for. If she had not joined Navy, she could have pursued higher education and got a better rank," she added.

Activists said it was rare for transgender people to win such legal battles. "It is rare in the public sector and almost never happens in the private," said Vvajanti Vasanta Mogli, an activist based in Hyderabad

ED notice to **Amnesty for** alleged FEMA violations

New Delhi: The Enforcement Directorate recently issued a show cause notice to Amnesty International India Pvt Ltd, the Indian arm of the Amnesty International, UK, for Rs 52 crore remittances it had received from its parent body in UK in violation of the Foreign Exchange Management Act (FEMA).

Sources said, the order is sued by the special director of ED on July 25 this year was for alleged violation of FEMA under "Borrowing and Lending Regulations" to the tune of Rs 51.72 crore for "rendering civil societies activities in India by getting remittances from parent body Amnesty International, UK in the garb of export of services"

Amnesty India has been under scrutiny of the investigative agencies for some time. In October last year, the ED had conducted searches at its Bengaluru office in connection with its probe in the alleged violation of FDI guidelines and remittances it had received from the parent body Its director Akar Patel's residences were among premises searched by the agency then.

The agency was probing if the Amnesty adopted the FDI route to evade the foreign contribution regulation act as the government had tightened laws under FCRA and had cancelled registrations of hundreds of NGOs for their "anti-India" activities.

Doc writes to CJI on Assam lynching, SC treats it as PIL

New Delhi: The Supreme Court on Thursday lodged a petition based on an email sent by an Agra-based paediatrician, who cited a TOI news report and highlighted the recent lynching of a 75-year-old doctor in an Assam tea estate. He sought urgent remedial measures to stop attacks on doctors.

Sanjay Kulshreshtha, a paediatric surgeon in a hospital for women and children in Delhi Gate area of Agra, sent a link of the video showing lynching of the doctor and wrote to CJI Ranjan Gogoi that unless immediate steps were taken against such attacks, "no doctor will choose to go to villages or small towns even if there happens to be a glut of doctors because of more number of medical colleges'

Citing the TOI report headlined 'Assam tea garden workers beat doc to death', Kulshreshtha said, "The community he served did not hesitate for once in beating him to death. Decades of service, outof-hour help, solicited advices to patients he served were washed away and forgotten as he was violently thrashed by a moment of alleged questionable service inadequacy." TNN

SIT on Pehlu lynching probe files report

Jaipur: The special investigation team (SIT), formed on August16this year to reinvestigate the Pehlu Khan lynching case after a trial court acquitted all six accused in the matter, submitted its report on Thursday.

The 80-page report, with additional 1,000 pages of containing documents, is likely to put the Rajasthan police in a tight spot for its shoddy investigation of the case.

A top official informed TOI on condition of anonymity that "several lacunas" have been identified at all levels of the investigation, including at the level of CID-CB's probe.

"The CID-CB had given clean chit to some of the accused mentioned by Pehlu Khan on grounds that their mobile tower locations on the day of the incident were found to be at a gaushala and not at the crime scene. But the SIT team found that the distance between the crime scene on the highway and gaushala was 2 km, the mobile towers can surely change in such a short distances, The CID-CB should have been aware of this fact," an official told TOI. The issue is that a time should come that no one gets penalised and everyfollows the rules. Around five lakh accidents occur in the country every

Some experts who support high penalties have, however, raised concerns over the singular application of the amended law on traffic offenders with little accountability assigned to road owning agencies and law enforcing authorities. how issues to do with road conditions, faulty signages, and poor maintenance of traffic signals are yet to be fully addressed. The only provision against road owning agencies is a Rs 1 lakh fine if faulty designs lead to any fatal accidents.

'This provision of fine should be extended to all road owning agencies... We expect the government will include such provisions in the new Motor Vehicles Rules, which will be prepared for enforcement of the entire law," said Piyush Tiwari of Save Life Foundation.

A study by road safety expert Rohit Baluja in 2017 had highlighted how 75% of road signages in Delhi are faulty and confusing for commuters. He maintains that until everything in the law is explained clearly and without any ambiguity, there will be subjective en-
