CJI in 'urgent' meet, SC skips **Ayodhya case** on Monday

New Delhi: The Supreme Court's five-judge constitution bench did not hear the Ayodhya land dispute case on Monday owing to an urgent meeting of CJI Ranjan Gogoi.

Five chairs for the judges were in place till 10.30 am, the scheduled time for commencement of hearing, and the counsel for parties had taken their seats in the front rows as it was the turn of senior advocate CS Vaidyanathan, appearing for deity Ram Lalla, to conclude his argu-

ments on Monday. But a little later, two chairs were removed by the court staff, indicating that an alternative three-judge bench would take up other cases.

However, at 10.45 am, it was announced that the alternative bench too would not sit on Monday, thus cancelling the day's listed business before the CJI's court. Justice S A Bobde, who is part of the fivejudge bench for the Ayodhya matter, too did not take up cases listed for hearing as an alternative bench in the event the constitution bench did not sit. Speculation was rife as to the reason behind the sudden cancellation of the Ayodhya hearing, which has been progressing on a day-to-day basis on all five week days. SC sources said the Chief Justice of India and Justice Bobde had urgent engagements and did not elaborate on the reason for the cancellation.

House Panel Gives Week's Time To LS Ex-MPs To Vacate Houses

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New Delhi: A parliamentary panel on Monday gave a week's utlimatum to former Lok Sabha MPs to vacate their government accommodations so that new members can move in. The house committee of Lok Sabha also decided to stop power and water supply to the houses within three days where ex-MPs have been overstaying. 'We have allotted accom-

modation to 300 MPs. But many of them could not shift to their official accommodations since these have not been vacated. We have directed officials concerned to snap electricity and water connection where they find people are still staying. We are hopeful of almost everyone vacating their houses. It will take a month or two to get the vacated accommodations ready for new allottees," house committee chairman Chan-

There were reports of nearly 200 former law makers overstaying in the government accommodations. All those awaiting for their official accommodations have been staying in transit accommodations.

According to norms, former MPs need to vacate their official accommodations within a month of dis-

The 16th Lok Sabha was dissolved on May 25 and all the ex-lawmakers should have vacated their houses by June 25. "The house committee has no power to give any extension to current ac-

commodation of former

MPs," Patil said. Later in the day PM Modi tweeted, "When a new session of Parliament begins, newer MPs face lot of trouble as far as finding accommoda-

tion is concerned. I am glad efforts have been made to overcome this problem".

TOI has learnt that even some of the new ministers have been waiting for their official accommodation as the former ones are yet to vacate their homes. Sources said some of the re-elected MPs, who did not find place in the Cabinet, would need to get the new house from Lok Sabha pool to vacate the current accommodation.

King of the jungle turns scavenger outside Gir

Ahmedabad: As it moves away from the wild and closer to humans, the king of the jungle is hunting less and

scavenging more. A path-breaking study on feeding habits of lions in Gujarat reveals that 75% of lion food inside the Gir sanctuary is hunted wildlife. However, outside the sanctuary 70% of their food consists of livestock. A bigger cause of concern is that only 20% of this livestock is hunted while about 50% is scavenged feed, which includes either dying or dead animals abandoned by locals,

The study, 'Ecology of Lion in agro-pastoral Gir landscape, Gujarat', has been conducted by Y V Jhala, Kausik Banerjee and Parabita Basu of Wildlife Institute of India. It needs mention that Sarasiya Virdi in Amreli district — the epicenter of the deadly Canine

Distemper Virus outbreak that killed 29 lions last year was one such dumping ground of ill and dead cattle. The forest department doesn't allow disposal of carcasses in the area.

The study says a high percentage of killing of livestock by lions in villages outside the protected area augurs intense man-animal conflict in the future. Last counted in 2015, Gujarat housed 523 lions. The number of lions is estimated to have swelled to over 700.

Of these, about 50% of them live outside the protected area, mainly in four neighbouring districts namely Bhavnagar, Amreli, Porbandar and Gir Somnath. Lion experts, however, flag a more serious concern. "As lions move out of the wild and get closer to humans, easy availability of livestock, especially baits and dead animals, is blunting hunting skills of lions, especially cubs," said Y V Jhala.

The researcher recounts how they witnessed a cub feeding on a live bait without killing it first. Forest officials suggested disposal of cattle carcasses in lion habitats should not be allowed. "This will ensure lions are mandated to kill their preyand keep their hunting skills honed, he said. "This would also prevent outbreak of CDV like



that the Islamic preacher has been summoned by Malaysian authorities after his alleged racial remarks. The 53-year-old preacher, who is permanent resident in Muslim-majority Malaysia, had his statement recorded for the first time on August 16, the report said.

Reacting to Naik's comments, Mahathir on Sunday said it was "quite clear" Naik wanted to participate in racial politics. "He is stirring up racial feelings. The police will have to investigate

whether it is causing tension; obviously, it is," he said.

Mahathir added that as a permanent resident, Naik was not allowed to participate in politics. "You can preach (religiously). But he wasn't doing that," he said. "He was talking about Chinese going back to China and Indians going back to India. I have never said such things. But he did. That is politics," Mahathir said. Several of his cabinet ministers have publicly called for Naik to be kicked out.

The government has in the past appeared reluctant to move against Naik for fear it could upset some Muslims as well as provide ammunition to political opponents. AGENCIES
