

17 killed as truck rams into tempo and van in UP

AT LEAST 17 people, including a woman and three children, were killed and around half a dozen others were injured when a speeding truck rammed into a van before overturning on a van in Shahjahanpur district on Tuesday morning.

Eyewitnesses said that after the truck rammed into the tempo from behind, it fell on a van, which was ahead of the tempo and was filled with passengers.

Prima facie, police said, the truck driver fell asleep and lost control, thereby causing the accident. The truck driver, however, managed to escape and is absconding, they added.

“People helped the police to rescue the victims. The injured have been sent to a local hospital. All the arrangements have been made there. I, along with the District Magistrate, visited the them,” said Shahjahanpur SP Shivvasimpi Channappa.

According to a senior police officer, the truck, carrying a consignment of clothes, was coming from Sitapur, while the tempo with 4-5 passengers in it was on its way to Shahjahanpur from Bartara. The van was on its way to Bahadurganj.

Bareilly Division Commissioner Ranvir Prasad said a magisterial inquiry would be conducted to ascertain if the accident was a result of the truck driver’s laxity.

# In MP, police seek to recover protest ‘cost’ from BJP leader

MILINDGHATWAI BHOPAL, AUGUST 27

IN A move that’s causing politicians in the state to sit up and take notice, the Madhya Pradesh police has proposed that the Bhopal district magistrate recover Rs 23.76 lakh from a former BJP legislator for organising a protest without permission in the state capital last week.

BJP leader Surendra Nath Singh, who lost the 2018 Assembly elections to the Congress’ Arif Masood, had mobilised protests at nearly a dozen places across the city on August 20, calling for a ‘gherao’ of Chief Minister Kamal Nath’s official residence to protest the “deteriorating law and order situation in the state” and a drive to evict vendors. He was arrested on the day along with 12 other saffron party leaders.

Singh is the same leader who had stirred a controversy in July when he had threatened to spill Nath’s blood if an eviction drive against illegal vendors was not stopped.

The unannounced protests on August 20 had caused traffic jams across the city and hundreds of policemen had to be deployed to stop the protesters from approaching the CM’s bungalow.

Inspector General of Police (Bhopal Range),

Yogesh Deshmukh, told *The Indian Express* that the proposal was sent as scores of extra police personnel had to be deployed to maintain law and order on the day. “Police personnel from different areas, who would have been on other official work, had to be withdrawn and deployed. There has to be a cost to it and some accountability fixed,” the IG said, adding, “people miss flights, trains and students their examinations when they get caught in sudden traffic jams. They curse the administration, get frustrated and (eventually) go back to their work.”

Deshmukh said the police was not against protests. He said taking requisite permission would allow the administration to divert traffic and make other arrangements. He argued that such a fine can be recovered from Singh if powers enjoyed by the district magistrate under Section 133 of the CrPc (conditional order for removal of nuisance) are broadly used.

Singh however, was unfazed by the move. “How could have I announced in advance the gherao of the CM’s bungalow? Nobody will permit it,” he said. He added that he would not be deterred by such moves and would continue to hold protests without permission. “Let them put me in jail,” he said.

“Don’t they shut down an entire city (for security reasons)

during the Prime Minister’s visits? Should he stop travelling because it causes inconvenience to people?,” questioned the BJP leader, and warned that the police officials behind the move would “suffer the consequences when there is a change of power in the state”.

Bhopal Collector Tarun Pithode said he was examining the police’s proposal. “The intention is good. Those who cause losses should compensate for it,” the collector said. He was yet to find a provision under which he could initiate proceedings against the former legislator.

“The move is tantamount to crushing democracy. We will crush such mentality. If the Kamal Nath government goes ahead and tries to recover the amount, we will hold protests across the state against such controversial orders. One can understand such recovery if someone damages property or causes communal riots,” said former CM Shivraj Singh Chouhan adding nothing like this has been done ever in the past.

The move faced flak from the ruling Congress leaders as well. Congress MLA Kunal Chaudhary said the move was not proper because everyone has a right to air one’s views. He said dharnas and similar forms of protests are routine in a democracy and people can’t be fined for them.

UP madrasa clerk detained for ‘filming’ girls changing clothes

A CLERK of a madrasa in Kushinagar district was detained for allegedly filming girl students changing in a room, via a Close Circuit Television (CCTV) camera on August 15.

The madrasa authorities, however, have denied the allegation — made by the parents of the girls who were participants of a cultural programme organised on the occasion of Independence Day.

The complaint was lodged on Monday, even as the police are to register a case.

When contacted, madrasa principal Shahid Ali said false allegations were made to malign the image of the institution, which was established in 2002.

“The 15 local residents, whose signatures are in the complaint, had told us that they had not signed any such letter. I have also checked footage of the CCTV camera and there is nothing in it. Someone had made a false complaint to malign the image of the madrasa,” said the principal, adding that the clerk was detained.

“Since classes were not held on Independence Day, the cameras installed inside the madrasa rooms were blocked. We had allotted two rooms to the participants... the complaint almost over a week after,” said Ali.

When contacted, Circle Officer of Kushinagar, Ramdas Prasad, said the allegation is yet to be established. “An inquiry is on. We have detained one person for questioning,” he said.

## First woman DGP Kanchan Chaudhary Bhattacharya dies

KANCHAN CHAUDHARY Bhattacharya, the country’s first woman Director General of Police (DGP), died at a hospital here after prolonged illness, an official said on Tuesday. She

was 72. Chaudhary breathed her last late Monday night at a private hospital in Mumbai, an official said, adding that she is survived by her husband and two daughters.

She was undergoing medical treatment for prolonged illness since last few months, Uttarakhand

Police said in a tweet.

They also remembered Chaudhary, a 1973-batch Indian Police Service (IPS) officer, as the first woman DGP of any state in the country.

The IPS Association in a tweet remembered her for her “sterling qualities of head and heart”, and an il-

lustrious career “adorned with many firsts and awards”.

Born in Himachal Pradesh, Chaudhary was the country’s second woman IPS officer after Kiran Bedi. She led the Uttarakhand Police force as DGP from 2004 to October 31, 2007.

# Goa Opposition collecting details to ‘examine rationale’

THE GOA Opposition is examining if a state’s Chief Minister can occupy an executive position in the Goa university by collecting details from other states. Leader of the Opposition, Digambar Kamat said on Tuesday.

Earlier in the month, Chief Minister Pramod Sawant had announced that he would introduce a Bill in the Assembly to make him the pro-chancellor of the Goa University. Currently, the university has a Vice-Chancellor and the Governor of the state is listed as the ex-officio visiting Chancellor.

“The intent needs to be studied as this was never heard of in Goa. When I was the chief minister, I never intervened and still had a good engagement with the students and their welfare. We are go-

ing through every university in the country and trying to understand if this has shaped elsewhere, and if so what is the status and rationale for it. We are also studying how does such a decision shape out,” said Kamat.

Sawant had said the reason behind the move was the “welfare of Goans”. To this, Kamat said on Tuesday the “reason too does not give a correct picture. We are hence studying that position too.”

Sawant’s announcement had stirred up criticism from various sections of society. Former State Election Commissioner and political analyst Prabhakar Timble took to write a column in a local daily. This (Sawant’s move) is going to create a situation where the office of the Vice-Chancellor will often be at loggerheads with the office of the CM in future, he wrote.

KARTARPUR CORRIDOR

India, Pak likely to hold last technical meet on August 30

THE ONGOING tension between India and Pakistan notwithstanding, the two countries will be holding the fourth, and possibly the last, technical level meeting on Kartarpur corridor at the Dera Baba Nanak on August 30.

The corridor will be opened in November to mark the 550th birth anniversary of Guru Nanak Dev. “It is fourth such meeting at Dera Baba Nanak and hopefully the last. There may not be any further meeting on technical level as almost all the issues regarding the corridor have been settled,” said a National Highway Authority of India (NHAI) official.

Technical meetings are facilitated by the Border Security Force and Pakistan Rangers.

Giving the details of the agenda for the meeting, the NHAI official said the two countries will hold discussions regarding the architecture of a bridge to be built over the flood water causeway. “Building the bridge will take some time, so we will also discuss the details pertaining to setting up of a temporary service road for the time being. This service road will stretch into both the countries,” the official said.

The bridge has been a bone of contention between India and Pakistan.

While India wants a bridge over the Zero Line and has already begun constructing one on its side, Pakistan wants to build a causeway. India has been insisting that the causeway would lead to flooding of Indian areas during monsoon.

“As per a decision taken by the two countries, now the construction of the bridge will start after the 550th birth anniversary celebrations of Guru Nanak Dev is over,” the NHAI official added.

Another official said that the provision of constructing an entry gate at the Zero Line, just like the one at Attari-Wagah border, can also be discussed.

# Not opposing deity's plea: Nirmohi Akhara

**New Delhi:** Nirmohi Akhara on Tuesday dropped its strong opposition to deity Ram Lalla's suit claiming ownership over the 2.77 acres of Ram Janmabhoomi-Babri Masjid land in Ayodhya to settle for a conciliatory approach where it said it would never seek relief at the cost of the deity's interests.

At the beginning of Day 13 of proceedings, senior advocate Sushil Jain read out Nirmohi Akhara's statement on maintainability of the suit filed by Devki Nandan Agarwal on behalf of the deity Ram Lalla. "The Akhara will not press the issue of maintainability of suit number 5 of 1989, which has been filed on behalf of the deities through Agarwal as their next friend provided other Hindu parties do not press or question the 'sevait' right of Akhara in relation to the deities in question and maintainability of Nirmohi Akhara's suit," Jain said.

"A suit filed by Akhara 'as a sevait' is a suit filed by and on behalf of the deities. The relief sought by Akhara for 'restoration of charge and management from receiver' cannot be categorised as a relief against the interest of the deities for which it can be said that they should be represented as a defendant through a disinterested next friend,"

Jain told a bench of Chief Justice Ranjan Gogoi and Justices S A Bobde, D Y Chandrachud, Ashok Bhushan and S Abdul Nazeer.

However, Jain clarified that the Akhara's stand required a similar gesture from other Hindu parties.

Senior advocate P N Mishra, appearing for Ram Janmasthan Punaruthan Samiti (RJPS), gave an interesting twist to the proceedings. He cited various historical accounts given by Hans Baker, Alois Anton Fuhrer, Henry Beveridge and Z A Desai to question the popular perception that Babur's general Mir Baqi constructed the Babri Masjid in Ayodhya in 1528 AD, two years after Babur conquered India and established Mughal rule.

Mishra said these historical accounts based on translation of inscriptions on pillars and slabs rendered a confusing and unrealistic account. The references variously

mention the mosque being constructed by Mir Baqi in 1528, by Mir Khan in 1523, by Abdul Baqi Isphani in 1516 as well as contained reference to being built by Baqi Tashkandi and Mir Baqu. "So who was the person who constructed it?" he asked.

Moreover, Babur Nama and Babur's daughter's Humayun Nama, the two biographical accounts of the first two Mughal emperors, did not make any mention of Babri Masjid being built in Ayodhya though these referred to many areas around Ayodhya, Mishra said.

Mishra said this was the reason why Allahabad HC had said, "We are perturbed by the manner in which Ashraf Hussain/Desai have tried to give an impeccable authority to the tests of alleged inscriptions which they claim to have existed on the disputed building though repeatedly said that the original text has disappeared. The fallacy and complete misrepresentation on the part of the author in trying to give colour of truth to this text is writ large from a bare reading of the write-up. We are really at pains to find that such blatant fallacious kind of material has been allowed to be published under the authority of Archaeological Survey of India, government of India, without caring about its accuracy, correctness and genuineness of the subject."

## 'Yellow journalism hurting institutions, maligning people' Issue Needs To Be Examined: SC

**New Delhi:** The Supreme Court on Tuesday expressed concern over the "rise of yellow journalism" which it said was damaging institutions and maligning people and added that the issue needed to be examined. It said freedom of press was supreme but it could not be one-way traffic.

A bench of Justices Arun Mishra, M R Shah and B R Gavai passed the remarks while hearing an appeal filed by news portal "The Wire" and its journalists who are facing a defamation suit filed by Jay Shah, son of home minister Amit Shah.

Jay Shah had moved the lower court alleging defamation by the news portal and its journalists after an article claimed that his company's turnover grew exponentially after the BJP-led government came to power at the Centre in 2014.

Although the bench allowed the portal's plea to withdraw its appeal against the Gujarat high court's gag order on publishing of the article, it disapproved the practice followed by media houses to give short notice of a few hours to people to respond before filing a story against them.

"The institution has suffered a lot. We have suffered.

How has this culture come up in India. Why should we not take the issue suo motu and settle it. It is most unfortunate that an important case is being withdrawn. We want his matter to be decided. We are worried as judges of this court," the bench said when senior advocate Kapil Sibal, appearing for the portal, urged the court to allow it to withdraw the petitions.

While reporting the sexual harassment case against CJI Ranjan Gogoi, some news portals gave a short time to the SC registry to respond and, then, went ahead to post the report. On Tuesday, however, the bench did not explicitly refer to that episode.

"This is a serious issue and it has to be examined. This is nothing but yellow journalism," the bench said, while allowing the petitioner to withdraw the appeal but kept the larger issue open for adjudication in appropriate proceedings. Sibal agreed with the bench's concern and said he was ready to assist the court on the issue.

The bench allowed the portal to withdraw the petition and face proceedings in the trial court. It, however, asked the trial judge to decide the case on merit without being influenced by the SC's observations.

## No rules yet to cut crashes due to high-tension cables

**Mumbai:** High-tension power supply wires and cable lines have been the bane of helicopter and small fixed-wing aircraft pilots worldwide, having caused hundreds of fatal accidents. On Tuesday, all the six passengers of a private aircraft which reportedly got entangled in electricity wire and caught fire after hitting the ground had a narrow escape in Aligarh. A helicopter accident last week in Uttarkashi, which killed three people, is also believed to have happened because of the power supply wires that went unnoticed by the pilots, until it was too late to recover the aircraft and fly over the obstacle. However, unlike regulators in other countries, India is yet to formulate norms for state governments and power-supply companies, aimed at cutting down the number of wire-strike crashes, say industry experts.

"In other countries, like Australia, for instance, the rule is that any transmission company setting up cables, mostly in valleys, should put up markers. Our Directorate General of Civil Aviation doesn't talk about it," said a senior helicopter pilot.

### Plane crashes in UP, lucky escape for six



The wreckage of a trainer aircraft VT-AVV with six people on board, including two pilots, that crashed during a landing attempt at Aligarh's Dhanipur airstrip on Tuesday. The plane was trying to land on the extended part of the runway that was yet to get operational. A magisterial probe has been ordered into the incident

main unmarked.

Capt Uday Gelli, western region president of Rotary Wing Society of India, said: "We believe that installing aerial marker balls on high-tension wires crisscrossing valleys in northern parts of India should be made mandatory." An aerial marker ball is a bright orange fibre glass ball, weighing about 20 kgs and about 2-3 feet in diameter, which is installed along the power supply lines to alert pilots about the obstacle in their flight path. "The question remains how long can we continue to accept such accidents. It is time the DGCA sends out a strong message to state governments, the local

district administration and power producers laying transmission lines," said Capt Gelli.

The US Helicopter Safety Team found approximately 16% of all rotary-wing accidents involve wire or obstacle strikes. The US civil aviation regulator, FAA, studied 124 wire-strike accidents involving civil helicopters between 1994 and 2004 and found 86% of fatal accidents occurred in clear weather with good visibility.

Unlike navigation charts used by airline pilots, those used by general aviation pilots aren't updated regularly and don't carry all the needed information to prevent wire strikes.
